By-Laws

SUBJECT: POWERS, DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BOARD AND ITS OFFICERS

The powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Board include the following:

- a. Appoint a District Superintendent of Schools and, at its discretion, provide for payment of supplementary salary to the District Superintendent of Schools by the BOCES;
- b. Prepare and adopt a budget for the Board programs for the ensuing year no later than May 15 of each year;
- c. Assess each component district a share of the administrative, rental, and capital budgets by the ratio of full value of Resident Weighted Average Daily Attendance (RWADA to the same measure of the entire district);
- d. Upon the recommendation of the District Superintendent employ such assistants, teachers, supervisors, clerical help and other personnel necessary to carry out the program;
- e. Provide and maintain suitable classrooms, office and other facilities necessary to carry out the program;
- f. Provide requested cooperative services;
- g. Provide transportation, facilities, and equipment for the delivery of services.
- h. Establish policies which provide the framework for the day-to-day operations;
- i. Such other powers and duties as prescribed by law.
